

2019 HIGHLIGHTS & OVERVIEW

Continuing long-term trends (slow planets moving through certain signs)

Pluto in Capricorn 2008 - 2024

Neptune in Pisces (in its sign of rulership) 2012 - 2025

Saturn in Capricorn (in its sign of rulership) 12/19/17 - 2020

Major Sign Changes Chiron into Aries 2/18 for 8 years; Uranus into Taurus 3/6 for 7 years

Jupiter in Sagittarius (which it rules) most of 2019 - see house locations on next page

Most important Aspects

Jupiter square Neptune - year's toughest link, exact three times (as are many aspects):

- 1/13 (Venus and Sun push this square 1/19 - 1/22; emphasized at 1/21 Lunar Eclipse)
- 6/16 (Mars amplifies this square 7/4 - 7/7 (and connects to Uranus 7/11))
- 9/21 (triggered by Mercury 10/4 - 10/5 and by Venus 10/9 - 10/12)

Uranus semisquare Neptune 5/19 is final of 5 instances from 2017 to 2019 (incl. 12/15/18)

Jupiter sesquiquadrate Uranus 1/9, 6/6 (close to 6/16 Jupiter-Neptune square), 10/14

Saturn sextile Neptune three times: 1/31, 6/18, 11/8

Chiron quintile Pluto (twice in 2018) 5/21 & 10/18; Saturn quintile Chiron (not exact until 12/14);

Mars forms QTs three times: 4/22 - 4/26 (see "Big Bumps"), 8/4 - 8/16, 11/27 - 12/3

Jupiter trine Uranus (only once) 12/15 (accentuated by 12/26 Solar Eclipse)

Nodes & Eclipses in North Node in Cancer * South in Capricorn 11/15/18 - 6/4/20 (last Leo eclipse is 1/21); Nodes square Eris at Spring Equinox; So. Node conjunct Pluto 3/28;

Saturn conjunct South Node three times: 5/20, 6/23 (close at both July Eclipses) & 9/15

Toughest Eclipse 7/16 Lunar Eclipse / runner-up 1/21 Lunar Eclipse

Easiest (least noxious) Eclipse 7/2 Solar Eclipse

Toughest Seasonal Chart - Summer Solstice / Easiest Seasonal Chart - Winter 2019

Toughest Month - July (2 eclipses, most planets Retrograde at once, including Mercury)

Easiest Month - August / runners-up - November & December

Mars (in its 2-year orbit) visits its sign of rulership, Aries, 12/31/18 - 2/14/19; joins Uranus at the last degree of Aries on 2/13; later, Mars is "out of bounds" 4/20 - 6/22

Big Bumps

late April - early May: Uranus-Neptune 5/1 semisquare activated by Mars 4/27 and Mercury 5/8;

6/16 Jupiter-Neptune square activated by Mars 5/5 and by Mercury 5/10

Mars again activates Jupiter-Uranus-Neptune aspects 7/4 - 7/11 (between eclipses)

Mars makes a T-square 9/12 - 9/14 (Full Moon) with the Jupiter-Neptune square (exact 9/21)

Little Bumps

Venus semisquare Neptune & conjunct Uranus 5/18 (Full Moon), sesquiquadrate Jupiter 5/20

Mercury conjunct Mars 6/18, both oppose Saturn 6/14 - 6/16 (at 6/17 Full Moon) & Pluto 6/19

"Geodetic" Indications - Chiron at end of Pisces is in UK, passes 0° Aries at Greenwich and soon will leave UK degrees - Will Brexit get worked out? Or be reversed?

Uranus in Taurus (over the coming years) moves through Middle East and over Moscow degrees

Washington Geodetic equivalent is 17° Capricorn. Pluto was here 2016 (March - May) & Jan.

2017 (at Inauguration). Saturn ("karma time") will be here Feb. - March 2019 & Nov. 2019.

SIGN BY SIGN (Some of these factors are mentioned on the prior page.)

ARIES Ruler Mars in Aries, joins Eris 2/3 and Uranus; frequently activates aspects of slower planets (Jupiter-Uranus-Neptune tangle); Chiron enters Aries; Mars Out of Bounds

TAURUS Uranus enters Taurus 3/6 for 7 years; Sun conjunct Uranus 4/23; Uranus semisquare Neptune 5/1; Ruling planet Venus in Taurus 5/15 - 6/8 (see "Little Bumps")

GEMINI Ruler Mercury triggers Uranus-semisquare-Neptune 5/8; Mercury is in Gemini 5/21 (enters with Sun!) until 6/4, aspecting Uranus 5/29 and Neptune & Jupiter 5/30. Always pay attention to Mercury Rx!

CANCER North Node in Cancer 11/15/18 - 6/4/20; 7/2 Solar Eclipse at 10°; Mercury conjunct Mars in Cancer (see "Little Bumps"); Mercury Rx partly in Cancer

LEO 1/21 last eclipse in Leo for 8-9 years; Mercury Rx partly in Leo; Mars activates Jupiter-Uranus-Neptune (see "Big Bumps"); Sun & Venus conjunct 8/14 in Leo, trine Jupiter 8/7 - 8/8

VIRGO Venus conjunct Mars in Virgo 8/24, both trine Uranus 8/26 - 8/28; degrees in Virgo receive T-square from Jupiter-Neptune square, Mars activates this square (see "Big Bumps"). Always pay attention to Mercury Rx!

LIBRA Mercury & Venus both enter Libra 9/14; marriage asteroid Juno visits 11/3/19 - 9/20/20.

SCORPIO At 4/24 Rx station, ruler Pluto is almost square Eris (not exact until 2020). Mercury and Venus connect to Jupiter/Uranus/Neptune tangle in the first half of Oct. (Mercury 10/4 - 10/7, Venus 10/9 - 10/12). (This almost made the list for "Little Bumps.")

SAGITTARIUS Ruler Jupiter in Sag. 11/8/18 - 12/2/19; triggers Uranus-Neptune semisquare (1/9 - 1/13 & not as exact 6/6 - 6/16). Venus in Sag. square Neptune 1/20 & conjunct Jup. 1/22.

CAPRICORN See prior page re: Pluto, Saturn & So. Node. Solar Eclipse 1/5 15°, Lunar Eclipse 7/24 24°, Solar Eclipse 12/26 4°. Sun & Mercury spark Uran.-Nept. 1/18 - 1/23. Jupiter enters 12/2.

AQUARIUS See ruler Uranus. Sun semisquare Neptune 1/19 & Jupiter 1/20. Mercury & Sun conjunct 1/29, semisquare Venus 1/29 - 2/2. New Moon 2/4 at 15° ("cross-quarter degree").

PISCES Ruler Neptune semisquare Uranus (part of change-over from Age of Pisces to Age of Aquarius) - 1st hard aspect in cycle begun at 1993 conjunction; 3 times Jupiter square Neptune & Saturn sextile Neptune; Uran.-Nept. semisq. activated by Mercury 2/18 - 2/19, by Sun 3/5 - 3/6, by Venus 4/9 - 4/10. Mercury Retro. in Pisces 3/5 - 3/28 & conjunct Neptune 2/19, 3/24, 4/2.
